1. Remove the orange safety clip.
2. Point spray opening at bear's face.
3. Press firmly on trigger and release spray in short bursts.

For this product to be fully effective, you must engulf the bear's face, especially the eyes, nose and mouth. This product generally has a range of approximately 15-20 feet. The canister empties in approximately 9 seconds. Wind and other conditions may alter the range of effectiveness. Shield your eyes and face if you must face the wind.
